

AMENDED DISASTER / LOCKDOWN REGULATIONS

These amendments were published on 26 March 2020

The changes appearing below are most relevant to general members of the public

1. Private motor vehicles

Amended – now may not carry more than **60%** of the licenced capacity (it was 50%).

This means that if your car is licenced to carry 5 people, it can now carry 3 people including the driver
It's still 50% for buses, taxis & ubers

2. Essential products

Additional essential products that may be purchased

- Products for the care of babies and toddlers (e.g. nappies, etc.)
- Personal toiletries including hair-care, body and face washes, roll-ons, deodorants, toothpaste etc.

3. Essential services

Additional & amended essential service work that can be carried out:

- added for e.g. tow trucks & vehicle recovery, call centres providing service to critical services, agricultural harvesting & a few others
- we can send the full list on request

4. Places and premises closed to the public

- addition of restaurants (was an obvious omission in the initial list)
